FINANCIAL INTEREST IN ANY CONTRACT, JOB, WORK OR SERVICE BY THE COUNTY, UNLESS IT IS OF SUCH A NATURE TO MEET THE APPROVAL OF THE GUIDELINES OF THE ETHICS BOARD.

3. SOLICIT OR ACCEPT ANY SERVICE OR THING OF VALUE, DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY UPON MORE FAVORABLE TERMS THAN THOSE GRANTED TO THE PUBLIC GENERALLY AS DEFINED BY THE GUIDELINES OF THE ETHICS BOARD, FROM ANY PERSON, FIRM OR CORPORATION HAVING BUSINESS DEALINGS WITH THE COUNTY OR FINANCIAL INTEREST IN ANY CONTRACT, JOB, WORK, OR SERVICE FOR THE COUNTY.

4. PARTICIPATE IN A RECOMMENDATION OR A DECISION AFFECTING ANY PERSON, FIRM, OR CORPORATION, HAVING BUSINESS DEALINGS WITH THE COUNTY OR AFFECTING A PERSON, FIRM OR CORPORATION IN WHICH HE OR HIS SPOUSE HAS A FINANCIAL INTEREST.

5. SOLICIT OR ACCEPT DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY ANY GIFT, GRATUITY, FAVOR, ENTERTAINMENT, LOAN OR ANY OTHER THING OF MONETARY VALUE FROM ANY PERSON, FIRM OR CORPORATION INTERESTED DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY, IN ANY MANNER WHATSOEVER IN BUSINESS DEALINGS WITH THE COUNTY, IF SUCH ACTION IS IN VIOLATION OF THE GUIDELINES SET FORTH BY THE ETHICS BOARD.

6. REPRESENT A PRIVATE INTEREST BEFORE ANY COUNTY AGENCY.

7. APPEAR AS AGENT OR ATTORNEY AGAINST THE COUNTY IN ANY LITIGATION TO WHICH THE COUNTY, OR ANY AGENCY THEREOF IS A PARTY; EXCEPT THAT HE MAY, IF NOT OTHERWISE PROHIBITED BY LAW OR REGULATION, ACT AS AGENT, ATTORNEY OR OTHER REPRESENTATIVE FOR ANY COUNTY OFFICER OR EMPLOYEE WHO IS SUBJECT TO DISCIPLINARY OR OTHER PERSONNEL ADMINISTRATION PROCEEDINGS IN CONNECTION WITH TRIAL PROCEEDINGS; AND HE MAY ALSO ACT AS AGENT OR ATTORNEY FOR HIMSELF, HIS PARENTS, SPOUSE, CHILD, OR FOR ANY PERSON FOR WHOM, OR FOR ANY ESTATE FOR WHICH HE IS SERVING AS GUARDIAN, EXECUTOR, ADMINISTRATOR, TRUSTEE, OR OTHER PERSONAL
