UNLESS THE PUBLIC OFFICIAL EXPRESSLY INDICATED TO THE APPLICANT THAT HE FAVORED THE GRANTING OF SUCH AN APPLICATION ON THE SPECIFIC PROPERTY, BUSINESS LOCATION OR FACTS AS EVENTUALLY FILED.

5A-5 CONFIDENTIAL STATEMENTS.

1. ALL ELECTED OFFICIALS, DEPARTMENT HEADS, MEMBERS OF BOARDS, AND COMMISSIONS WHERE COMPENSATION IS PAYABLE IN WHOLE OR IN PART FROM COUNTY FUNDS AND SUCH EMPLOYEES OR REGULATORY AND OTHER AGENCIES AS MAY BE DESIGNATED BY THE BOARD OF ETHICS WITHIN SUCH TIMES AND IN THE MANNER AND FORM PRESCRIBED BY THE BOARD OF ETHICS SHALL FILE A CONFIDENTIAL STATEMENT OF EMPLOYMENT AND FINANCIAL INTERESTS. THE BOARD SHALL MAINTAIN THESE FORMS IN THE STRICTEST CONFIDENCE AND THEY SHALL NOT BE SUBJECT TO PUBLIC DISCLOSURE UNDER SECTION 203 OF THE CHARTER.

2. THE BOARD OF ETHICS SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR REVIEWING THE CONFIDENTIAL STATEMENTS, COUNSELING AND ADVISING THE OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES REQUIRED TO FILE SUCH STATEMENTS AND TO ISSUING SUCH REMEDIAL ORDERS AS THE BOARD DEEMS FIT AND PROPER.

3. THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE SHALL REQUIRE THE COUNTY PERSONNEL OFFICER TO FURNISH THE BOARD WITH A LIST OF OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES SUBJECT TO THIS FILING REQUIREMENT AT SUCH TIMES AS THE BOARD REQUESTS.

5A-6 EXEMPTIONS.

THE PROHIBITIONS SET FORTH IN THIS CODE ABOVE SHALL NOT BE CONSTRUED TO PROHIBIT:

1. ANY OFFICER OR EMPLOYEE FROM BEING AFFILIATED WITH, EMPLOYED BY OR REPRESENTING A PERSON, FIRM OR CORPORATION WHOSE DIRECT AND INDIRECT INTEREST IN BUSINESS DEALINGS WITH THE COUNTY FORMS AN INSUBSTANTIAL PART OF ITS TOTAL BUSINESS, PROVIDED THAT HE HAS NO DIRECT OR INDIRECT INTEREST IN SUCH BUSINESS DEALINGS AND RECEIVED NO PART OF THE BENEFIT THEREOF AND TAKES NO ACTIVE PART IN CONNECTION THEREWITH.

2. ANY OFFICER OR EMPLOYEE FROM APPEARING BEFORE ANY AGENCY UPON MATTERS ONLY INCIDENTIALLY
