

COUNTY LOCAL LAWS

MAY BE OF THE SAME POLITICAL PARTY. THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE SHALL DESIGNATE ONE MEMBER AS CHAIRMAN. NO MEMBERS OF THE BOARD SHALL BE AN OFFICER OR EMPLOYEE OF THE COUNTY, OR A MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT THEREIN.

C. THE TERM OF OFFICE OF EACH MEMBER OF THE BOARD SHALL BE FROM THE DATE OF HIS APPOINTMENT UNTIL THE TERMINATION OF THE TERM OF OFFICE OF THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE. A MEMBER APPOINTED TO FILL A VACANCY OCCURRING PRIOR TO THE EXPIRATION OF THE TERM FOR WHICH HIS PREDECESSOR WAS APPOINTED SHALL BE APPOINTED IN THE SAME MANNER AS PRESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION A ABOVE AND SHALL SERVE FOR THE REMAINDER OF SUCH TERM.

D. EACH MEMBER OF THE BOARD SHALL BE PAID \$100 (ENTITLED TO \$50) FOR EACH DAY THE BOARD MEETS OR FOR EACH DAY A MEMBER PERFORMS DUTIES ON BEHALF OF THE BOARD, BUT IN NO EVENT TO EXCEED \$7,200 IN ANY ONE FISCAL YEAR. MEMBERS SHALL ALSO BE REIMBURSED FOR ACTUAL EXPENSES INCURRED FOR WORK OF THE BOARD IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE COUNTY'S ACCOUNTING PROCEDURE MANUAL.

E. THE BOARD SHALL MEET AT THE CALL OF THE CHAIRMAN, NOT LESS THAN ONCE A MONTH, AND AT SUCH OTHER TIMES AS MAY BE REQUESTED BY THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE OR COUNTY COUNCIL.

F. TWO MEMBERS SHALL CONSTITUTE A QUORUM FOR THE TRANSACTION OF BUSINESS.

G. THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE SHALL FURNISH THE BOARD STENOGRAPHIC SERVICES, PHYSICAL FACILITIES AND OTHER NECESSARY ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES.

H. THE BOARD MUST ADVISE THE OFFICER OR EMPLOYEE AT THE INCEPTION OF THE HEARING THAT HE MAY ELECT TO REMAIN SILENT, AND IF HE DOES NOT, THEN ANYTHING HE MAY SAY OR OFFER INTO EVIDENCE MAY BE USED AGAINST HIM IN OTHER PROCEEDINGS WHICH MAY BE INSTITUTED.

I. AN OFFICER OR EMPLOYEE WHO IS SUBJECT TO PROCEEDINGS UNDER THIS LAW SHALL BE GIVEN AN OPPORTUNITY TO PARTICIPATE IN THE HEARING AND TO BE REPRESENTED BY ANY PERSON OF HIS OWN CHOOSING. HE OR HIS REPRESENTATIVE SHALL BE AFFORDED THE OPPORTUNITY FOR CROSS-EXAMINATION OF ALL
