- (5) A DETAILED SUMMARY OF EACH SIGNIFICANT CONTACT BY A QUALIFIED MENTAL HEALTH PROFESSIONAL WITH THE PATIENT; AND
- (6) A COPY OF THE INDIVIDUALIZED POST-HOSPITALIZATION PLAN AND ANY MODIFICATIONS THERETO, AND A SUMMARY OF THE STEPS THAT HAVE BEEN TAKEN TO IMPLEMENT THAT PLAN; AND
- (7) A MEDICATION HISTORY AND STATUS, WHICH INCLUDES THE SIGNED ORDERS OF THE PRESCRIBING PHYSICIAN. NURSES SHALL INDICATE BY SIGNATURE THAT PHYSICIANS' ORDERS HAVE BEEN CARRIED OUT; AND
- (8) A SUMMARY OF THE RESULTS OF EACH PHYSICAL EXAMINATION; AND
- (9) AN EVALUATION WHICH NOTES THE ONSET OF ILLNESS, THE CIRCUMSTANCES LEADING TO ADMISSION, THE PATIENT'S ATTITUDE AND BEHAVIOR ON ADMISSION, AN ESTIMATE OF HIS INTELLECTUAL FUNCTIONING, MEMORY FUNCTIONING AND ORIENTATION, IN DESCRIPTIVE, NOT INTERPRETIVE FASHION; AND
- (10) A SUMMARY OF THE CHIEF COMPLAINTS OF THE PATIENT AND THE CHIEF COMPLAINTS OF OTHERS REGARDING THE PATIENT: AND
- (11) A PERIODIC REVIEW BY ONE QUALIFIED MENTAL HEALTH PROFESSIONAL OF THE TREATMENT PLAN WHICH ANALYZES THE SUCCESSES AND FAILURES OF THE TREATMENT PLAN AND DIRECTS WHATEVER MODIFICATIONS ARE NECESSARY: AND
- (12) A WEEKLY SUMMARY OF THE EXTENT AND NATURE OF THE PATIENT'S WORK ACTIVITIES AS PROVIDED FOR IN THE TREATMENT PLAN, AND THE EFFECT OF THE ACTIVITY UPON THE PATIENT'S PROGRESS UNDER THE TREATMENT PLAN; AND
- (13) AN ORDER SIGNED BY A QUALIFIED MENTAL HEALTH PROFESSIONAL FOR ANY RESTRICTIONS ON VISITATIONS AND COMMUNICATIONS: AND
- (14) AN ORDER SIGNED BY A QUALIFIED MENTAL HEALTH PROFESSIONAL FOR ISOLATION OR FOR ANY PHYSICAL RESTRAINTS ON THE PATIENT'S FREEDOM OF MOVEMENT ABOUT THE HOSPITAL OR FACILITY; AND
- (15) A DETAILED SUMMARY OF ANY EXTRAORDINARY INCIDENT IN THE HOSPITAL OR FACILITY INVOLVING THE PATIENT. THE SUMMARY SHALL BE ENTERED BY ANY STAFF MEMBER HAVING PERSONAL KNOWLEDGE OF THE INCIDENT AND SHALL CLEARLY SPECIFY HIS SOURCE OF INFORMATION. UPON COMPLETION, THE SUMMARY SHALL BE READ AND INITIALED BY A QUALIFIED MENTAL HEALTH PROFESSIONAL WITHIN TWENTY-FOUR (24) HOURS.11
- (N) ON OR AFTER OCTOBER 1, 1973, EVERY PATIENT IN OR ADMITTED TO ANY FACILITY LICENSED BY OR UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE DEPARTMENT SHALL HAVE AN
