CHAPTER 347

(House Bill 1395)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 1-18 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Cecil County (1970 Edition, being Article 8 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland), title "Cecil County," subtitle "Administration," subheading "Article II. County Commissioners," to increase the salary of the County Commissioners of Cecil County.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section 1-18 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Cecil County (1970 Edition, being Article 8 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland), title "Cecil County," subtitle "Administration," subheading "Article II. County Commissioners," be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:
