TITLE 8. WATER AND WATER RESOURCES.

SUBTITLE 1. IN GENERAL.

8-101. DEFINITIONS.

(A) IN THIS TITLE, THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED:

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection presently appears as Article 96A, section 2 (a) of the Code. The only changes made are in style.

(B) "ADMINISTRATION" MEANS WATER RESOURCES ADMINISTRATION.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection presently appears as Article 96A, section 2(d) of the Code, as amended by Chapter 348, Acts of 1972. The only changes made are in style.

(C) "APPROPRIATE COUNTY GOVERNING BODY" MEANS THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ANY NON-CHARTERED COUNTY OR THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF ANY CHARTERED COUNTY IN WHICH A PORTION OF THE WATERSHED IS LOCATED.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language derived from Article 66C, section 411A(b) of the Code. This definition is used to avoid the repetitive use of phrases indicating that county commissioners are intended in the case of a non-charter county and that county council is indicated in the case of a charter county.
