8-406. CONSTRUCTION, OPERATION, OR MAINTENANCE OF DAMS.

A DAM OR OTHER STRUCTURE IMPEDING THE NATURAL FLOW OF A SCENIC RIVER MAY NOT BE CONSTRUCTED, OPERATED, OR MAINTAINED IN A SCENIC RIVER, AND CHANNELIZATION MAY NOT BE UNDERTAKEN, UNLESS THE SECRETARY SPECIFICALLY APPROVES.

8-407. COOPERATION BY STATE UNITS.

[[WHEN EXERCISING ITS RESPONSIBILITY RELATING TO A DESIGNATED SCENIC RIVER,]] EVERY STATE UNIT SHALL RECOGNIZE THE INTENT OF THE SCENIC RIVERS PROGRAM AND TAKE WHATEVER ACTION IS NECESSARY TO PROTECT AND ENHANCE THE SCENIC QUALITIES OF THE DESIGNATED RIVER.
