

CHARGES ON USERS LOCATED IN THE COUNTY OR EMPLOY ANY OTHER MEANS OF ASSESSMENT AND COLLECTION AUTHORIZED BY LAW FOR COLLECTION OF TAXES OR ASSESSMENTS, INCLUDING IMPOSING LIENS ON REAL OR PERSONAL PROPERTY.

8-512. DETERMINING ASSESSMENTS; RECALCULATION TRIENNIALY.

AN ASSESSMENT SHALL BE DETERMINED WHEN THE FIRST PAYMENT IS DUE. PROJECTIONS OF WATER WITHDRAWALS IN DETERMINING ASSESSMENTS BEGIN WITH THE MOST RECENT YEAR FOR WHICH DATA ARE AVAILABLE. THEREAFTER, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT, THE AUTHORITY SHALL RECALCULATE ASSESSMENTS TRIENNIALY BASED ON A REVISED TEN-YEAR PROJECTION OF WATER WITHDRAWALS BEGINNING WITH THE MOST RECENT YEAR FOR WHICH DATA ARE AVAILABLE.

8-513. RECEIPT OF FUNDS AUTHORIZED; BORROWING FROM STATE AND REPRESENTED COUNTY.

THE AUTHORITY MAY RECEIVE FROM THE STATE, ITS POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS, THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT, OR ANY OTHER SOURCE, FUNDS TO APPLY TO ITS OBLIGATIONS AND DUTIES UNDER THIS SUBTITLE. IT MAY BORROW FROM THE STATE AND ANY REPRESENTED COUNTY, AND THEY MAY LEND TO THE AUTHORITY, FUNDS THE AUTHORITY REQUIRES TO MEET OBLIGATIONS UNDER ITS CONTRACT WITH THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT.
