8-603. PERMIT PREREQUISITE TO DRILLING.

A LICENSED WELL DRILLER MAY NOT UNDERTAKE ANY OPERATION TO BORE, CORE, DIG, OR CONSTRUCT A WELL FOR ANY COWNER WHO IS REQUIRED TO OBTAIN A PERMIT FOR PRODUCTION AND APPROPRIATION OF WATERS FROM A WELL UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS TITLE UNTIL THE OWNER HAS OBTAINED THE PERMIT FROM THE DEPARTMENT. A PERMIT MAY NOT BE REFUSED FOR DOMESTIC USE ON A FARM.

8-604. PERMIT TO DRILL WELL REQUIRED; REPORT OF DRILLER ON COMPLETION OF WORK.

A WELL MAY NOT BE DRILLED UNTIL THE DEPARTMENT ISSUES A PERMIT. IN APPLYING FOR A PERMIT, THE DRILLER SHALL GIVE THE DEPARTMENT THE INFORMATION IT REQUIRES. AS A CONDITION TO ISSUING A PERMIT, THE DEPARTMENT MAY REQUIRE SAMPLES OF THE MATERIALS ENCOUNTERED IN DRILLING THE WELL TO BE PRESERVED AND SUBMITTED TO IT. ON COMPLETION OF THE DRILLING OF ANY WELL, THE DRILLER SHALL FILE A FINAL REPORT WITH THE DEPARTMENT GIVING THE LOG OF EACH WELL, SIZE AND DEPTH, DIAMETERS AND LENGTHS OF CASING AND SCREEN INSTALLED, STATIC AND PUMPING LEVELS, YIELD OF THE WELL, AND ANY OTHER INFORMATION PERTAINING TO CONSTRUCTION OR OPERATION OF THE WELL THE DEPARTMENT REQUIRES.
