

(G) SEAL.—THE BOARD SHALL ADOPT A SEAL WITH A DESIGN THE GOVERNOR APPROVES. ITS IMPRESSION AND DESCRIPTION SHALL BE FILED WITH THE OFFICE OF THE SECRETARY OF STATE.

(H) INSPECTION OF LICENSES AND RECORDS; COPIES OF RECCRDS.—ANY LICENSE OR OTHER OFFICIAL RECORD KEPT IN THE BOARD'S OFFICE UNDER ITS AUTHORITY SHALL BE OPEN FOR PUBLIC INSPECTION UNDER RULES AND REGULATIONS THE BOARD PRESCRIBES. COPIES OF ANY BOARD RECORD OR PROCEEDING, DULY CERTIFIED AND AUTHENTICATED BY ITS SEAL ARE ADMISSIBLE IN EVIDENCE IN ANY COURT.

8-608. COMPLIANCE WITH PART III REQUIRED.

ANY PERSON DOING BUSINESS IN THE STATE AS A WELL DRILLER SHALL COMPLY WITH THE APPLICABLE PROVISIONS OF PART III OF THIS SUBTITLE.

8-609. SCOPE AND APPLICATION OF PART III.

(A) ANY LICENSE OR AUTHORITY OTHER THAN AS ISSUED OR PERMITTED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF PART III OF THIS SUBTITLE MAY NOT AUTHORIZE ANY PERSON IN THE STATE TO ENGAGE IN BUSINESS AS A WELL DRILLER. A COUNTY MAY NOT REQUIRE THAT A PERSON OBTAIN AN AUTHORIZATION OR LICENSE TO DO BUSINESS AS A WELL DRILLER IN THE COUNTY. THE PROVISIONS OF PART III OF THIS SUBTITLE DO NOT DENY ANY COUNTY, UNIT OF THE STATE, OR ANY POLITICAL SUBDIVISION THE RIGHT TO ADOPT AND ENFORCE ORDINANCES, RULES, AND REGULATIONS WITH RESPECT TO WELLS OR TO THE USE OF WATER.
