8-610. BOARD'S AUTHORITY TO GRANT LICENSES; FEE; EXPIRATION AND RENEWAL OF LICENSES; TEMPORARY LICENSES; BOND AND INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS.

(A) GRANTING LICENSES AND FEES.--THE BOARD MAY GRANT VARIOUS LICENSES, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, MASTERS, APPRENTICES, AND RESTRICTED LICENSES TO ANY PERSON INTENDING TO ENGAGE IN THE BUSINESS OF WELL DRILLING IN THE STATE. THE BOARD SHALL ISSUE A WELL DRILLER'S LICENSE TO ANY APPLICANT WHO QUALIFIES UNDER AND COMPLIES WITH THE PROVISIONS OF PART III DEALING WITH WELL DRILLERS. THE LICENSE SHALL BE IN THE MANNER, TERMS, AND CONDITIONS AS PROVIDED BY STATUTE, OR RULE OR REGULATION, AND GRANTED ON PAYMENT OF A \$25 ANNUAL FEE.

(E) LICENSE EXPIRATION AND RENEWAL.--EVERY LICENSE ISSUED SHALL EXPIRE ON JUNE 30 NEXT FOLLOWING THE DATE OF ISSUANCE UNLESS IT IS REVOKED OR SUSPENDED PRIOR TO THAT TIME. A RENEWAL LICENSE SHALL BE ISSUED ON APPLICATION AND PAYMENT OF THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE. AN EXAMINATION MAY NOT BE REQUIRED OF AN APPLICANT FOR A RENEWAL LICENSE.
