(B) NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION, IN ANY FISCAL YEAR THE DEPARTMENT MAY EXPEND FROM THE WATERWAYS IMPROVEMENT FUND WITHOUT LEGISLATIVE APPROVAL A TOTAL SUM OF NOT MORE THAN \$150,000. OF THIS AMOUNT, \$125,000 MAY BE EXPENDED FOR SMALL PROJECTS UNDER § 8-707 (3) AND (4), SUBJECT TO THE LIMITATION THAT NO ONE SINGLE PROJECT OF THIS KIND MAY EXCEED \$5,000 IN COST TO THE WATERWAYS IMPROVEMENT FUND, AND \$25,000 SHALL BE EXPENDED FOR BOATING SAFETY AND EDUCATION.

8-710. MANUFACTURER'S OR DEALER'S LICENSE.

(A) REQUIRED.—A MANUFACTURER OR DEALER MAY NOT CONDUCT HIS BUSINESS IN THE STATE UNLESS LICENSED AS A MANUFACTURER OF OR DEALER PURSUANT TO RULES AND REGULATIONS THE DEPARTMENT ADOPTS.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection presently appears as Article 14B, section 4 - 0(a) of the Code. The phrase "in vessels" is proposed for deletion because the definition in section 8-701 now applies only to manufacturers or dealers in vessels. The only other changes made are in style.

(B) APPLICATION; OATH; PAYMENT OF FEE.—APPLICATION FOR A MANUFACTURER'S OR DEALER'S LICENSE IS MADE ON THE FORM THE DEPARTMENT PRESCRIBES AND CONTAINS THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF THE APPLICANT. IF THE APPLICANT IS A PARTNERSHIP, THE APPLICATION SHALL INCLUDE THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF EACH PARTNER. IF THE APPLICANT IS A CORPORATION, THE APPLICATION SHALL CONTAIN THE NAMES OF THE PRINCIPAL OFFICERS OF THE CORPORATION, THE STATE OF INCORPORATION, THE ADDRESSES OF EVERY PLACE WHERE THE BUSINESS IS CONDUCTED, THE NATURE OF THE BUSINESS, AND ANY OTHER INFORMATION THE DEPARTMENT REQUIRES. EVERY APPLICATION SHALL BE VERIFIED BY OATH OR AFFIRMATION OF THE APPLICANT, IF AN INDIVIDUAL, OR BY THE PARTNER OR OFFICER IF THE APPLICANT IS A PARTNERSHIP OR
