

8-715. OWNER'S CERTIFICATE OF TITLE - IN GENERAL.

(A) APPLICATION REQUIRED.—EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B), ANY OWNER OF A VESSEL PRINCIPALLY USED ON THE WATERS OF THE STATE AND TO BE NUMBERED SHALL APPLY TO THE DEPARTMENT FOR A CERTIFICATE OF TITLE FOR THE VESSEL.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection presently appears as Article 14B, section 4A(a) of the Code, as amended by Chapter , H.B. 989, Acts of 1973. The only changes made are in style.

(E) CONTENTS AND FORM PRESCRIBED BY DEPARTMENT.
- EACH CERTIFICATE OF TITLE SHALL CONTAIN THE INFORMATION AND SHALL BE ISSUED IN A FORM THE DEPARTMENT PRESCRIBES.

(C) PREREQUISITE TO CERTIFICATE OF NUMBER.—THE DEPARTMENT MAY NOT ISSUE OR RENEW A CERTIFICATE OF NUMBER TO ANY VESSEL REQUIRED TO BE REGISTERED AND NUMBERED IN THE STATE UNLESS THE DEPARTMENT HAS ISSUED A CERTIFICATE OF TITLE TO THE OWNER.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection presently appears as Article 14B, section 4A(b) of the Code. The exception clause is proposed for deletion since section 4B is proposed for repeal. The only other changes made are in style.

(D) EXCEPTION FOR PERSON OWNING ON JULY 1, 1965.
- A PERSON WHO, ON JULY 1, 1965, IS THE OWNER OF A VESSEL WITH A VALID CERTIFICATE OF NUMBER ISSUED BY THE STATE IS NOT REQUIRED TO FILE AN APPLICATION FOR A CERTIFICATE OF TITLE FOR THE VESSEL UNLESS HE TRANSFERS ANY PART OF HIS INTEREST IN THE VESSEL OR HE RENEWS THE CERTIFICATE OF NUMBER FOR THE VESSEL.

(E) APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS.—EVERY OWNER OF A VESSEL SUBJECT TO TITLING UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE SHALL APPLY TO THE DEPARTMENT FOR ISSUANCE OF
