

ILLEGIBLE CERTIFICATES SHALL BE RETURNED TO THE DEPARTMENT WITH THE APPLICATION FOR A DUPLICATE.

(B) MARKING AND DELIVERY OF CERTIFICATE.—THE DUPLICATE CERTIFICATE OF TITLE SHALL BE MARKED FLAINLY "DUPLICATE" ACROSS ITS FACE, AND MAILED OR DELIVERED TO THE APPLICANT.

(C) RECOVERY OF LOST OR STOLEN ORIGINAL CERTIFICATE.—IF A LOST OR STOLEN ORIGINAL CERTIFICATE OF TITLE FOR WHICH A DUPLICATE HAS BEEN ISSUED IS RECOVERED, THE ORIGINAL SHALL BE SURRENDERED PROMPTLY TO THE DEPARTMENT FOR CANCELLATION.

8-718. OBTAINING MANUFACTURER'S OR IMPORTER'S CERTIFICATE OF TITLE.

A MANUFACTURER OR DEALER MAY NOT TRANSFER OWNERSHIP OF A NEW VESSEL WITHOUT SUPPLYING THE TRANSFEREE WITH THE MANUFACTURER'S OR IMPORTER'S CERTIFICATE OF ORIGIN SIGNED BY THE MANUFACTURER'S OR IMPORTER'S AUTHORIZED AGENT. THE CERTIFICATE SHALL CONTAIN INFORMATION THE DEPARTMENT REQUIRES.

8-719. DEALER'S RECORD OF VESSELS BOUGHT, SOLD, OR TRANSFERRED.

EVERY DEALER SHALL MAINTAIN FOR THREE YEARS A RECORD OF ANY VESSEL HE BOUGHT, SOLD, EXCHANGED OR RECEIVED FOR SALE OR EXCHANGE. THIS RECORD SHALL BE OPEN TO INSPECTION BY DEPARTMENT REPRESENTATIVES DURING REASONABLE BUSINESS HOURS.
