Subsection (d) presently appears as Article 66C, section 176(l) of the Code.

The only other changes made are in style.

10-510. MUTILATION OR DESTRUCTION OF TAG PROHIBITED.

A PERSON MAY NOT WILLFULLY OR WANTONLY REMOVE, MUTILATE, OR DESTROY ANY TAG ATTACHED TO THE OUTSIDE OF A CONTAINER IN WHICH ANY FUR OR PELT IS SHIPPED.

10-511. RECEIVING UNMARKED OR UNTAGGED FURS OR PELTS PROHIBITED.

A COMMON CARRIER OR HIS AGENT KNOWINGLY MAY NOT RECEIVE ANY FUR OR PELT OF ANY WILD QUADRUPED FOR SHIPMENT TO ANY POINT OUTSIDE OF THE STATE UNLESS IT IS TAGGED OR MARKED AS REQUIRED.

10-512. TAXIDERMIST AND FUR-TANNER'S LICENSE.

(A) TAXIDERMIST AND FUR-TANNER'S LICENSE REQUIRED. - ANY PERSON DESIRING TO COMMERCIALY PRACTICE THE ART OF TAXIDERMY OR FUR-TANNING OR WHO DESIRES TO MOUNT, PRESERVE, OR TAN ANY SPECIES OF WILD BIRD OR WILD QUADRUPED LEGALLY ACQUIRED FIRST SHALL APPLY FOR A TAXIDERMIST AND FUR-TANNER'S LICENSE.

(B) APPLICATION; FEE; ISSUANCE OF LICENSE. - A PERSON DESIRING A TAXIDERMIST AND FUR-TANNER'S LICENSE SHALL APPLY ANNUALLY ON FORMS THE SECRETARY SUPPLIES AND PAY A \$5 LICENSE FEE. UPON RECEIPT OF THE
