

AS A JUVENILE COURT, EXCEPT THE CIRCUIT COURT FOR MONTGOMERY COUNTY; AND

(2) THE CIRCUIT COURT OF BALTIMORE CITY SITTING AS A JUVENILE COURT.

(I) CUSTODIAN.

"CUSTODIAN" MEANS A PERSON, OR AGENCY, OTHER THAN A PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN, TO WHOM LEGAL CUSTODY OF THE CHILD HAS BEEN GIVEN BY ORDER OF THE COURT.

(J) DELINQUENT ACT.

"DELINQUENT ACT" MEANS AN ACT WHICH IS IN VIOLATION OF THE STATE VEHICLE LAW, ANY OTHER TRAFFIC VIOLATION, OR AN ACT WHICH WOULD BE A CRIME IF DONE BY A PERSON WHO IS NOT A CHILD.

(K) DELINQUENT CHILD.

"DELINQUENT CHILD" MEANS A CHILD WHO COMMITS A DELINQUENT ACT AND WHO REQUIRES SUPERVISION, TREATMENT, OR REHABILITATION.

(L) DEPENDENT CHILD.

"DEPENDENT CHILD" MEANS A CHILD WHO HAS BEEN DEPRIVED OF ADEQUATE SUPPORT OR CARE BY REASON OF THE DEATH, CONTINUED ABSENCE FROM THE HOME, OR PHYSICAL, MENTAL OR EMOTIONAL INCAPACITY OR DISABILITY OF HIS PARENT, GUARDIAN, OR OTHER CUSTODIAN.

(M) DETENTION.

"DETENTION" MEANS THE TEMPORARY CARE OF CHILDREN, WHO, PENDING COURT DISPOSITION, REQUIRE SECURE CUSTODY FOR THE PROTECTION OF THEMSELVES OR THE COMMUNITY, IN PHYSICALLY RESTRICTING FACILITIES.

(N) DISPOSITION HEARING.

"DISPOSITION HEARING" MEANS A HEARING TO DETERMINE

(1) WHETHER THE CHILD IS IN NEED OF SUPERVISION, TREATMENT, OR REHABILITATION; AND IF SO,

(2) THE NATURE OF THE SUPERVISION, TREATMENT, OR REHABILITATION.
