10-706. PERMITTEES REQUIRED TO STOCK SPECIAL DOG  
TRAINING AREAS; EXCEPTION.

EACH PERMITTEE ANNUALLY SHALL STOCK 25 GAME BIRDS  
OR MAMMALS FOR EVERY 100 ACRES USED AS A SPECIAL DOG  
TRAINING AREA AT HIS OWN EXPENSE UNLESS THE DEPARTMENT  
DETERMINES THAT THE AREA ALREADY IS STOCKED  
ADEQUATELY. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL SUPERVISE ANY  
STOCKING.

10-707. RIGHTS OF PERMITTEE; HUNTING AND TRAPPING  
PROHIBITED; EXCEPTION.

(A) RIGHTS OF PERMITTEE. - A PERMITTEE MAY TRAIN  
HIS OWN DOG OR ANY DOG OF ANOTHER PERSON AT ANY TIME  
IN THE SPECIAL DOG TRAINING AREA OR PERMIT OTHERS TO  
DO SO UNDER CONDITIONS THE PARTIES MUTUALLY AGREE TO.

(B) HUNTING AND TRAPPING PROHIBITED. - A  
PERMITTEE, OR ANY PERSON AUTHORIZED BY HIM, MAY ONLY  
HUNT OR TRAP NONGAME BIRDS AND MAMMALS AND PROTECTED  
BIRDS, EXCEPT WITHIN THE CONFINES OF A SPECIAL DOG  
TRAINING AREA.

10-708. DESTROYING BOUNDARY FENCES, WIRES, OR POSTERS  
PROHIBITED.

A PERSON MAY NOT WILLFULLY, NEGLIGENTLY, OR  
MALICIOUSLY CUT, REMOVE, COVER UP, DEFACE, OR  
OTHERWISE MUTILATE, INJURE, OR DESTROY ANY SPECIAL DOG  
TRAINING AREA BOUNDARY FENCE, WIRE, OR POSTER PLACED  
IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE.
