- SEC. 3-803. GENERAL JURISDICTION OF CIRCUIT COURT IN JUVENILE CAUSES; DIVISION FOR JUVENILE CAUSES OF CIRCUIT COURT OF BALTIMORE CITY.
- (A) EXCEPT IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY, THE CIRCUIT COURT FOR EACH COUNTY, HAS ORIGINAL JURISDICTION IN JUVENILE CAUSES AS DEFINED IN THIS SUBTITLE. WHEN THE CIRCUIT COURT EXERCISES THIS JURISDICTION, IT IS KNOWN AS "THE CIRCUIT COURT FOR _____ COUNTY, SITTING AS A JUVENILE COURT."
- (B) THE DIVISION OF THE CIRCUIT COURT OF BALTIMORE CITY EXERCISING JUVENILE JURISDICTION IS KNOWN AS THE DIVISION FOR JUVENILE CAUSES OF THE COURT. THE SUPREME BENCH OF BALTIMORE CITY SHALL ASSIGN ONE OR MORE JUDGES OF THE BENCH TO EXERCISE THIS JURISDICTION.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section presently appears as Art. 26, §51.

The provision dealing with general juvenile jurisdiction of the Circuit Court of Baltimore City is proposed for deletion as unnecessary; the definition section defines a court to include the Circuit Court of Baltimore City. The reference made in subsection (a) to Montgomery County is added to make clear on the outset that this section has no application to the circuit court of that county.

Subsection (b) of §51 is proposed for deletion also as unnecessary. It is incorporated in §3-801.
