(D) TENURE.

EACH MEMBER SERVES A TERM OF FIVE YEARS OR UNTIL HIS SUCCESSOR IS ELECTED AND QUALIFIED. A MEMBER IS NOT ELIGIBLE TO SERVE FOR MORE THAN TWO FULL SUCCESSIVE TERMS EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION. IF ANY MEMBER CEASES LEGALLY AND PHYSICALLY TO RESIDE IN THE STATE, HIS OFFICE IS VACANT.

(E) REMOVAL.

THE GOVERNOR SHALL REMOVE ANY MEMBER UPON RECOMMENDATION OF THE MARYLAND VETERINARY MEDICAL ASSOCIATION FOR MISCONDUCT IN OFFICE, INCOMPETENCE, IMMORALITY, WILLFUL NEGLECT OF DUTY, OR ANY CAUSE WHICH IS A GROUND FOR REVOCATION OF A LICENSE TO PRACTICE VETERINARY MEDICINE IN THE STATE. THE MEMBER MAY BE REMOVED ONLY AFTER REASONABLE NOTICE AND AN OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING IS PROVIDED.

SEC. 2-303. DISPOSITION OF FUNDS RECEIVED.

EVERY EXAMINATION AND ANNUAL REGISTRATION FEE RECEIVED BY THE BOARD SHALL BE PAID TO THE STATE AND BECOME GENERAL FUNDS OF THE STATE. THE MONEY RECEIVED SHALL BE DISPERSED BY THE COMPTROLLER PURSUANT TO AN APPROPRIATION MADE IN ACCORDANCE WITH §32 AND §52 OF THE CONSTITUTION OR PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF §§1 THROUGH 15, INCLUSIVE OF ARTICLE 15A OF THE CODE.
