SEC. 2-305. BOARD MAY ISSUE SPECIAL PERMIT AUTHORIZING USE OF SODIUM PENTOBARBITAL.

THE BOARD, UPON TERMS AND CONDITIONS IT FINDS PROPER, SHALL ISSUE TO ANY HUMANE SOCIETY, AS DEFINED BY §63 OF ARTICLE 27 OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND, OR COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL DESIGNATED ANIMAL SHELTER WHICH SUBMITS AN APPLICATION, A SPECIAL PERMIT AUTHORIZING PURCHASE, POSSESSION, AND USE OF SODIUM PENTOBARBITAL TO EUTHANIZE INJURED, SICK, HOMELESS, AND UNWANTED DOMESTIC ANIMALS. THE PERMIT SHALL DESIGNATE THE SINGLE PERSON RESPONSIBLE. THE APPLICATION FOR THE SPECIAL PERMIT SHALL BE ACCOMPANIED BY A \$15 FEE. THE ANNUAL RENEWAL FEE ALSO IS \$15. ANY ORGANIZATION THAT HAS RECEIVED A PERMIT PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION IS EXEMPTED FROM THE REGISTRATION REQUIREMENT OF §281 OF ARTICLE 27 OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND AS TO PENTOBARBITAL.

The present reference to "limited" permit is proposed for deletion and "special" permit is substituted to maintain consistency with the other provisions of this section. SEC. 2-306. REGULATION OF VETERINARY EDUCATION.

(A) BOARD HAS EXCLUSIVE AUTHORITY TO PRESCRIBE STANDARDS.

THE BOARD HAS THE EXCLUSIVE POWER TO ESTABLISH AND ALTER THE STANDARDS OF PRELIMINARY AND PROFESSIONAL EDUCATION AND TRAINING REQUIREMENTS OF APPLICANTS FOR THE EXAMINATION FOR A LICENSE.
