

SEC. 2-309. TEMPORARY PERMIT.

(A) APPLICANT TO ASSOCIATE WITH A LICENSED VETERINARIAN.

ANY VETERINARIAN APPLYING FOR A TEMPORARY PERMIT SHALL ASSOCIATE HIMSELF WITH A LICENSED AND REGISTERED VETERINARIAN IN THE STATE, AND HIS WORK SHALL BE LIMITED TO THE PRACTICE OF THE VETERINARY PRACTITIONER.

(E) CONTENTS OF PERMIT.

THE PERMIT SHALL BEAR THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF THE VETERINARY PRACTITIONER.

(C) FEE.

THE PERMIT FEE IS \$50. THIS SUM SHALL BE APPLIED TOWARD THE EXAMINATION FEE, BUT SHALL BE FORFEITED IF THE APPLICANT FAILS TO PRESENT HIMSELF AT THE NEXT SCHEDULED EXAMINATION WITHOUT BEING EXCUSED.

(D) APPLICANT SHALL TAKE EXAMINATION.

THE APPLICANT SHALL PRESENT HIMSELF FOR EXAMINATION AT THE NEXT SCHEDULED EXAMINATION OF THE BOARD UNLESS HE SUBMITS A WRITTEN APPLICATION FOR A WAIVER DETAILING THE REASONS FOR HIS NON-APPEARANCE AND THE BOARD WAIVES HIS APPEARANCE ON THE BASIS OF EXTREME HARDSHIP.

(E) DURATION OF PERMIT.

THE PERMIT SHALL EXPIRE ON THE DAY FOLLOWING THE ANNOUNCEMENT OF THE RESULTS OF THE FIRST EXAMINATION GIVEN AFTER THE TEMPORARY PERMIT IS ISSUED. THE TEMPORARY PERMIT OF AN APPLICANT WHO HAS BEEN GRANTED A WAIVER SHALL CONTINUE UNTIL THE ANNOUNCEMENT OF THE RESULTS OF THE NEXT FOLLOWING EXAMINATION.

(F) EXCEPTIONS.

ONLY ONE TEMPORARY PERMIT MAY BE ISSUED TO ANY APPLICANT. NO TEMPORARY PERMIT MAY BE ISSUED TO ANY APPLICANT IF HE PREVIOUSLY HAS FAILED THE EXAMINATION.
