SEC. 3-405. RULES AND REGULATIONS.

(A) RULES AND REGULATIONS.

THE SECRETARY MAY ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS HE DEEMS NECESSARY TO ADMINISTER THIS SECTION AND ENJOIN VIOLATIONS OF THE SECTION AND DEPARTMENTAL RULES AND REGULATIONS.

(B) RIGHT OF ENTRY.

THE SECRETARY OR HIS AGENT MAY ENTER ANY LOCATION TO CONDUCT REASONABLE INSPECTIONS IN ORDER TO ENFORCE THIS SECTION.

(C) AUTHORITY IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER AUTHORITY PROVIDED BY LAW.

THE AUTHORITY PROVIDED BY THIS SECTION AND §3-404 IS IN ADDITION TO AND NOT IN LIMITATION OF ANY OTHER AUTHORITY OF THE SECRETARY PROVIDED BY LAW.

SUBTITLE 5. DRIVING LIVESTOCK ON IMPROVED HIGHWAYS.

SEC. 3-501. DEFINITIONS.

(A) IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.
