SEC. 4-106. ADMINISTRATION.

THE SECRETARY MAY ENFORCE THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE THROUGH MEAT INSPECTORS, AGENTS, AND OTHER EMPLOYEES DESIGNATED OR APPOINTED CONSISTENTLY WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE. ALL INSPECTORS SHALL BE EMPLOYED UNDER THE STATE MERIT SYSTEM LAW EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN §4-104.

SEC. 4-107. SECRETARY MAY ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE; REPORTS.

IN ADDITION TO RULES AND REGULATIONS SPECIFICALLY AUTHORIZED BY THIS SUBTITLE, THE SECRETARY MAY ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS, AND REQUIRE REPORTS FROM PERSONS SUBJECT TO THIS SUBTITLE TO CARRY OUT THE PURPOSES AND PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE.

SEC. 4-108. INSPECTION OF LIVESTOCK CARCASS, MEAT, AND MEAT FOOD PRODUCTS PREPARED FOR INTRASTATE COMMERCE; CONDEMNATION.

(A) REQUIRED INSPECTIONS.

IN EACH OFFICIAL ESTABLISHMENT, THE SECRETARY MAY PERFORM THE FOLLOWING ACTS:

- (1) ANTEMORTEM INSPECTION;
- (2) POSTMORTEM INSPECTION; AND
