SEC. 4-118. LICENSE REQUIRED; FEE.

SUBJECT TO THE EXEMPTIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE, NO PERSON MAY ENGAGE IN THE BUSINESS OF SLAUGHTERING ANY LIVESTOCK, OR PREPARING OR LABELING ANY LIVESTOCK CARCASS, OR PART OF IT, FOR USE AS HUMAN OR ANIMAL FOOD, OR TRANSPORTING, BUYING, OR SELLING ANY DEAD, DYING, DISABLED, OR DISEASED LIVESTOCK WITHOUT OBTAINING AN ANNUAL LICENSE. THE SECRETARY SHALL ISSUE THE LICENSE FOR AN ANNUAL LICENSE FEE OF \$25.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section presently appears as Art. 66C, §470M(a) of the Code. The reference to "cattle, sheep, swine, goats, horses, mules, or other equines" is proposed for deletion and "livestock" substituted therefor in light of the definition of "livestock" set forth in §1-101(d). The only other changes made are in style.

SEC. 4-119. REGISTRATION OF WHOLESALERS, ANIMAL FOOD MANUFACTURERS, PUBLIC WAREHOUSEMEN, CUSTOM SLAUGHTERERS; RESTRICTIONS.

A PERSON SHALL REGISTER HIS NAME, THE ADDRESS OF EACH PLACE OF BUSINESS, AND ALL TRADE NAMES UNDER WHICH HE CONDUCTS BUSINESS, WHEN REQUIRED BY THE SECRETARY, IF HE ENGAGES IN ANY OF THE FOLLOWING BUSINESSES RELATING TO LIVESTOCK:

(1) CUSTOM SLAUGHTERER, MEAT BROKER, RENDERER, OR ANIMAL FOOD MANUFACTURER;

(2) WHOLESALER OF ANY LIVESTOCK CARCASS, OR PART OR PRODUCT OF IT;

(3) PUBLIC WAREHOUSEMAN STORING ANY LIVESTOCK CARCASS, OR PART OR PRODUCT OF IT;

(4) BUYER, SELLER, OR TRANSPORTER OF ANY DEAD, DYING, DISABLED, OR DISEASED LIVESTOCK OR ANY PART OF ANY CARCASS OF LIVESTOCK THAT DIED OTHERWISE THAN BY SLAUGHTER.
