(D) SUSPENSION OR TERMINATION OF EXEMPTION.

THE SECRETARY MAY SUSPEND OR TERMINATE BY ORDER ANY EXEMPTION UNDER THIS SECTION WITH RESPECT TO ANY PERSON IF THE SECRETARY FINDS THAT THIS ACTION AIDS IN EFFECTUATING THE PURPOSES OF THIS SUBTITLE.

SEC. 4-218. PROHIBITED ACTS.

NO PERSON MAY:

(1) SLAUGHTER ANY POULTRY OR PROCESS ANY POULTRY PRODUCTS CAPABLE OF USE AS HUMAN FOOD AT ANY ESTABLISHMENT PROCESSING ANY ARTICLES SOLELY FOR INTRASTATE COMMERCE, EXCEPT IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBTITLE;

(2) SELL, TRANSPORT, OFFER FOR SALE OR TRANSPORTATION, OR RECEIVE FOR TRANSPORTATION, IN INTRASTATE COMMERCE, (I) ANY POULTRY PRODUCT CAPABLE OF USE AS HUMAN FOOD WHICH IS ADULTERATED OR
