SEC. 5-207. LICENSES.

(A) LICENSE REQUIRED.

EACH CUSTOM APPLICATOR, PEST CONTROL CONSULTANT, AND PEST CONTROL OPERATOR SHALL OBTAIN AN ANNUAL LICENSE FROM THE SECRETARY, UNLESS HE IS EXEMPT BY §5-208.

(B) LICENSE FEE.

EACH APPLICATION SHALL BE ACCOMPANIED BY A \$30 LICENSE FEE AND EVIDENCE OF FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY AS REQUIRED BY THE SECRETARY.

(C) EXAMINATION.

EACH APPLICANT SHALL DEMONSTRATE HIS COMPETENCE TO USE AND APPLY PESTICIDES SAFELY IN THE STATE BY PASSING A WRITTEN OR ORAL EXAMINATION PREPARED AND ADMINISTERED BY THE DEPARTMENT.

(D) RENEWAL OF LICENSES.

ONCE GRANTED, EACH LICENSE SHALL BE RENEWED ANNUALLY UPON PAYMENT OF THE LICENSE FEE AND DEMONSTRATION OF THE REQUIRED EVIDENCE OF FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY AND SATISFACTORY KNOWLEDGE OF PESTICIDE USE.
