

(A) QUARANTINE.

UPON DISCOVERY OF FOUL BROOD, BLACK BROOD, OR OTHER INFECTIOUS OR CONTAGIOUS DISEASES IN ANY APIARY OR COLONY, THE SECRETARY SHALL SEND TO THE OWNER OF THE DISEASED BEES A WRITTEN ORDER REQUIRING THE BEES TO BE HELD IN QUARANTINE UNTIL RELEASED BY A WRITTEN PERMIT FROM THE SECRETARY.

(B) INSTRUCTIONS FOR TREATMENT.

UPON THE DISCOVERY OF FOUL BROOD, BLACK BROOD, OR OTHER INFECTIOUS OR CONTAGIOUS DISEASE IN ANY APIARY OR COLONY, THE SECRETARY SHALL INSTRUCT THE OWNER OR CARETAKER CONCERNING THE TREATMENT OF THE DISEASED COLONIES. IF, UPON SUBSEQUENT INSPECTION, THE DISEASE STILL IS FOUND TO EXIST IN THE APIARY OR COLONY, THE SECRETARY MAY DESTROY OR ORDER THE DESTRUCTION OF THE DISEASED COLONY IN A MANNER THAT PREVENTS THE SPREAD OF THE DISEASE.

SEC. 5-504. RIGHT OF ENTRY.

TO ENFORCE THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE SECRETARY MAY ENTER ALL PLACES WHERE BEES, BEE PRODUCTS, SUPPLIES, OR APPLIANCES USED IN APIARIES ARE KEPT.
