The only other changes made are in style.

SEC. 6-107. REGISTRATION.

(A) REGISTRATION OF COMMERCIAL FEED REQUIRED.

A PERSON SHALL REGISTER EACH COMMERCIAL FEED, EXCEPT CUSTOMER-FORMULA FEED AND CONTRACT FEED, BEFORE DISTRIBUTING IT IN THE STATE.

(B) REGISTRATION APPLICATION; COPY TO BE FURNISHED.

THE REGISTRATION APPLICATION SHALL BE SUBMITTED ON FORMS FURNISHED BY THE SECRETARY, AND SHALL ALSO BE ACCOMPANIED BY A LABEL OR OTHER PRINTED MATTER DESCRIBING THE PRODUCT IF REQUESTED BY THE SECRETARY. THE APPLICATION SHALL INCLUDE THE INFORMATION REQUIRED BY §§ 6-109, 6-110, AND 6-111. WHEN THE SECRETARY HAS APPROVED THE REGISTRATION, HE SHALL FURNISH A COPY TO THE APPLICANT.

(C) REGISTRATION FEE.

THE ANNUAL REGISTRATION FEE FOR EACH COMMERCIAL FEED DISTRIBUTED IN THE STATE IS \$20. CUSTOMER-FORMULA FEEDS AND CONTRACT FEEDS ARE EXEMPT IF THE REGISTRATION FEE IS PAID ON THE COMMERCIAL FEEDS WHICH THEY CONTAIN. IN ADDITION, ANY DISTRIBUTOR SHALL PAY AN ANNUAL REGISTRATION FEE OF \$25 FOR EACH BRAND OF COMMERCIAL FEED DISTRIBUTED IN INDIVIDUAL PACKAGES OF TEN POUNDS OR LESS.

(D) EXPIRATION DATE.

EACH REGISTRATION EXPIRES DECEMBER 31 EACH YEAR.

(E) EXCEPTION.

A DISTRIBUTOR IS NOT REQUIRED TO REGISTER ANY BRAND OF COMMERCIAL FEED WHICH HAS BEEN REGISTERED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE BY ANOTHER PERSON.
