SEC. 6-202. ADMINISTRATION.

THIS SUBTITLE SHALL BE ADMINISTERED BY THE STATE CHEMIST SUBJECT TO THE SUPERVISION OF THE SECRETARY.

All other present references to the State Chemist in this subtitle are proposed for deletion to reflect the department organization which includes the State Chemist as a unit within the department. SEC. 6-203. ENFORCEMENT: RULES AND REGULATIONS.

SEC. 6-204. FUND FOR PAYMENT OF ADMINISTRATION EXPENSES.
