SEC. 6-303. FEES CONSTITUTE A FUND.

ANY FEE COLLECTED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE CONSTITUTES A FUND TO DEFRAY PARTIALLY THE COST OF INSPECTION, SAMPLING, ANALYSIS, AND OTHER EXPENSES INCIDENT TO ADMINISTERING THIS SUBTITLE. ANY UNEXPENDED FUNDS SHALL REVERT TO THE GENERAL FUNDS OF THE STATE AT THE END OF THE FISCAL YEAR.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived from the last sentence of Art. 48, §144(a) of the Code and set forth here for organizational purposes. Although §144(a) presently refers to an inspection tax, it is intended that the proceeds from this are credited to the fund.

SEC. 6-304. SECRETARY MAY COLLECT SAMPLES; RIGHT OF ENTRY.

(A) SECRETARY MAY COLLECT SAMPLES.

THE SECRETARY MAY COLLECT SAMPLES OF AGRICULTURAL LIMING MATERIALS AND GYPSUM TO HAVE THEM ANALYZED AND SHALL PUBLISH THE RESULTS FOR PUBLIC INFORMATION.

(B) RIGHT OF ENTRY.

THE SECRETARY HAS FULL ACCESS, INGRESS, AND EGRESS TO AND FROM ANY PLACE OF BUSINESS, ANY QUARRY, KILN, FACTORY, BARN, BUILDING, LAND, OR VESSEL USED FOR MANUFACTURING, STORING, TRANSPORTING, OR SELLING AGRICULTURAL LIMING MATERIALS OR GYPSUM. THE SECRETARY MAY OPEN ANY CONTAINER OR PACKAGE CONTAINING OR SUPPOSED TO CONTAIN AGRICULTURAL LIMING MATERIAL OR GYPSUM AND TAKE ANY SAMPLE FOR ANALYSIS.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section presently appears as Art. 48, §146 of the Code. The phrase "agricultural liming materials and gypsum" is added because these are the materials covered by Art. 48, §140 of the Code. The only other changes made are in style.

SEC. 6-305. REGISTRATION.
