SEC. 7-316. RECONDITIONING AND REPACKING STAYED TOBACCO.

THE SECRETARY SHALL SHAKE OUT, RECONDITION, AND PACK ANY STAYED TOBACCO. THE TOBACCO THEN SHALL BE REWEIGHED AND THE INSPECTION SHALL BE RECORDED AS PROVIDED IN §§ 7-311 AND 7-313.

SEC. 7-317. TOBACCO REQUIRING COOPERAGE.

IF TOBACCO IS DELIVERED AT THE WAREHOUSE FOR INSPECTION IN A CONDITION THAT REQUIRES COOPERAGE, THE SECRETARY MAY REFUSE TO ACCEPT THE TOBACCO, OR MAY ACCEPT THE TOBACCO AND CHARGE A REASONABLE SUM TO REPAIR OR RECOOPER THE TOBACCO.

SEC. 7-318. FEES FIXED BY SECRETARY.

THE SECRETARY SHALL DETERMINE THE FEES TO BE CHARGED FOR SERVICES PROVIDED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE. THE OUTAGE FEE SHALL BE PAID BY THE SHIPPER.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived from Art. 48, §29 of the Code. The Subcommittee on Agriculture revised this section to permit the Secretary to set the fees charged for any service provided under this subtitle, not merely for reconditioning, repacking, and outage as the present statute provides.

SEC. 7-319. STORAGE - CNLY TOBACCO.

(A) SECRETARY MAY STORE TOBACCO; PREFERENCE TO GROWERS.

THE SECRETARY MAY RECEIVE TOBACCO FROM ANY GROWER OR OWNER, FOR STORAGE ONLY, IF HE DETERMINES THAT SPACE IS, OR IS REASONABLY ANTICIPATED TO BE, AVAILABLE IN THE WAREHOUSE FOR STORAGE-ONLY TOBACCO.
