

(C) "BRAND" MEANS THE NAME, TERM, DESIGN, OR TRADEMARK UNDER WHICH ANY PERSON OFFERS SOD FOR SALE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection presently appears as Art. 66C, §64A(u) of the Code. The only changes made are in style.

(D) THE TERMS "CERTIFIED", "APPROVED", "INSPECTED", "REGISTERED", "FOUNDATION", AND "BREEDER" WHEN REFERRING TO SOD, WHICH HAS BEEN PRODUCED OR COLLECTED, INSPECTED, AND LABELED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROCEDURES AND THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF AN OFFICIALLY RECOGNIZED CERTIFICATION AGENCY.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection presently appears as Art. 66C, §64A(q) of the Code. The order of the define terms is rearranged to correspond to qualitative hierarchy of these terms. The term "breeder" is added because this classification was omitted inadvertently in this definition even though "breeder" appears in this subtitle. See §9-108. The only other changes made are in style.

(E) "DEALER" MEANS ANY PERSON WHO SELLS, OFFERS OR EXPOSES FOR SALE, OR TRANSPORTS SOD FOR PLANTING PURPOSES WITHIN THE STATE, OTHER THAN A GROWER MAKING A CASUAL OR ISOLATED SALE OF UNSEVERED SOD.

(F) "KIND" MEANS ONE OR MORE RELATED SPECIES OR SUBSPECIES WHICH SINGLY OR COLLECTIVELY IS KNOWN BY ONE COMMON NAME.

(G) "LABELING" INCLUDES EVERY LABEL AND OTHER WRITTEN, PRINTED, OR GRAPHIC REPRESENTATION, IN ANY FORM, ACCOMPANYING OR PERTAINING TO ANY SOD AND INCLUDES EVERY REPRESENTATION OR INVOICE, BILL OF LADING, DELIVERY TICKET, OR OTHER RECEIPT.
