

PLUGS, DO NOT CONTAIN AT LEAST ONE-HALF INCH OF SOD AND ROOTS AND WHICH DO NOT REMAIN INTACT AFTER FOLDING, RCILING OR PLUGGING; OR

(9) CONTAINING ~~[[DANGEROUSLY]]~~ DESTRUCTIVELY INJURIOUS INSECTS, OTHER ANIMAL PESTS, OR PLANT DISEASES.

(B) ALTERING OR SUBSTITUTING SOD PROHIBITED.

A PERSON MAY NOT ALTER OR SUBSTITUTE SOD IN ANY MANNER THAT MAY DEFEAT THE PURPOSE OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE.

(C) DISSEMINATING FALSE OR MISLEADING ADVERTISEMENTS PROHIBITED.

A PERSON MAY NOT DISSEMINATE ANY FALSE OR MISLEADING ADVERTISEMENT IN ANY MANNER CONCERNING SOD, SOD MIXTURES, PLUGS, OR SPRIGS.

(D) FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH "STOP SALE" ORDER; SUPPLY FALSE INFORMATION; REMOVING TAGS PROHIBITED.

A PERSON MAY NOT FAIL TO COMPLY WITH, OR SUPPLY FALSE INFORMATION IN REPLY TO A "STOP SALE ORDER", OR REMOVE TAGS ATTACHED TO OR DISPOSE OF SOD, SOD MIXTURES, PLUGS, OR SPRIGS HELD UNDER THE ORDER, EXCEPT AS SPECIFIED BY THE ENFORCEMENT OFFICER.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section presently appears as Art. 66C, §64C of the Code. In subsection (a) (8) present reference to Art. 48, §70 is proposed for deletion because this section no longer exists. New language derived in part from subtitle 3 of Title 5 is added because this is the intended cross-reference. An amendment is added to refer to "destructively" injurious insects and plant diseases to reflect the subject matter of this subtitle, i.e., turf grass.

In subsection (d), the first phrase is proposed for deletion because it duplicates the provisions of §2-104(c).

The only other changes made are in style.
