(U) "RETAIL SEEDSMAN" INCLUDES ANY PERSON WHO SELLS, OR OFFERS, EXPOSES OR TRANSPORTS FOR SALE, SEEDS FOR PLANTING PURPOSES TO THE CONSUMER.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection presently appears as Art. 48, §148(c) of the Code. The only changes made are in style.

(V) "SEED" MEANS SEED, SPROUT, RHIZOME, SHOOT, [[OR]] EULBLET, FRUITS AND OTHER BODIES CAPABLE OF REGROWTH.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language suggested by the Department to define a term that is used in this subtitle without definition. The reference to "seed, fruit and other bodies capable of regrowth" is added by amendment to clarify the meaning of this definition.

(W) "STOP SALE" MEANS AN ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER PROVIDED BY LAW, RESTRAINING THE SALE, USE, DISPOSITION, AND MOVEMENT OF A DEFINITE AMOUNT OF SEED OF A SPECIFIC LOT.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection presently appears as Art. 48, §148(n) of the Code. The only changes made are in style.

(X) "TREATED" MEANS THE SEED HAS RECEIVED AN APPLICATION OF A SUBSTANCE OR PROCESS WHICH IS DESIGNATED TO REDUCE, CONTROL, OR REPEL CERTAIN DISEASE ORGANISMS, INSECTS, OR OTHER PESTS ATTACKING THE SEED OR SEEDLING GROWING FROM IT.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection presently appears as Art. 48, §148(u) of the Code. The only changes made are in style.

(Y) "TREE AND SHRUB SEED" INCLUDES THE SEEDS OF WOODY PLANTS AND HERBS, COMMONLY KNOWN AND SOLD AS TREE AND SHRUB SEEDS IN THE STATE.
