

MERCURIALS AND SIMILARLY TOXIC SUBSTANCES SHALL BE A POISON STATEMENT OR SYMBOOL.

(B) SEPARATE LABEL PERMITTED.

A SEPARATE LABEL CONTAINING THE REQUIRED INFORMATION STATEMENT MAY BE USED.

(C) MODIFICATION OR DENIAL OF STATEMENTS PROHIBITED.

THE STATEMENT MAY NOT BE MODIFIED OR DENIED IN THE LABELING OR ON ANOTHER LABEL ATTACHED TO THE CONTAINER.

REVISOR'S NOTE: Subsection (a) presently appears as Art. 48, §149 of the Code. The present phrase providing that this subsection applies to articles brought into this State "for sowing purposes" is proposed for repeal by amendment because it was concluded that this provision should apply to seeds used for any purpose.

Subsections (b) and (c) are new language derived from Art. 48, §149 of the Code.

The only changes made are in style.

SEC. 9-207. INFORMATION ON LABELS OR TAGS - AGRICULTURAL SEEDS; DETERMINATIONS FOR PURITY, GERMINATION, AND NOXIOUS WEED SEED SUBJECT TO RULES AND REGULATIONS.

(A) INFORMATION ON LABELS OR TAGS - AGRICULTURAL SEEDS.

EACH CONTAINER OF AGRICULTURAL SEEDS WHICH IS SOLD, OFFERED OR EXPOSED FOR SALE, OR TRANSPORTED IN THE STATE FOR PLANTING PURPOSES SHALL BEAR OR HAVE ATTACHED IN A CONSPICUOUS PLACE A PLAINLY WRITTEN OR PRINTED LABEL OR TAG IN THE ENGLISH LANGUAGE, EXCEPT WHEN THE SCIENTIFIC NAME IS THE COMMONLY ACCEPTED NAME, GIVING THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

(1) THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF THE PERSON WHO LABELED THE SEED OR WHO SELLS, OFFERS, OR EXPOSES THE SEED FOR SALE WITHIN THE STATE;

(2) COMMONLY ACCEPTED NAME OF (I) KIND, OR (II) KIND AND VARIETY, OF EACH AGRICULTURAL SEED
