

ACTION. THE ATTORNEY GENERAL, AT THE REQUEST OF THE COMMISSION, IMMEDIATELY SHALL INSTITUTE ACTION IN THE PROPER COURT FOR THE COLLECTION OF THE AMOUNT OF ANY TAX PAST DUE UNDER THIS SUBTITLE, INCLUDING INTEREST ON IT.

SEC. 10-408. REPORT OF APPLES SOLD.

EVERY GROWER SHALL SUBMIT TO THE COMMISSION BY DECEMBER 31 OF EACH YEAR A SIGNED AND SWORN STATEMENT OF THE AMOUNT OF COMMERCIAL APPLES SOLD BY HIM DURING THE PRECEDING CROP SEASON. THE STATEMENT SHALL BE REPORTED ON FORMS THE COMMISSION PRESCRIBES AND FURNISHES. ANY GROWER WHO, AFTER DECEMBER 31, SELLS COMMERCIAL APPLES PRODUCED THE PRECEDING YEAR SHALL FILE A SIGNED AND SWORN STATEMENT OF THE APPLES HE SELLS WITH THE COMMISSION NOT LATER THAN MAY 31.

SEC. 10-409. GROWER TO MAINTAIN RECORDS; INSPECTION BY COMMISSION.

THE GROWER SHALL MAINTAIN A COMPLETE RECORD OF APPLES HE SELLS AND SHALL PRESERVE IT FOR AT LEAST TWO YEARS FROM THE TIME THE APPLES ARE SOLD. THE RECORD SHALL BE OPEN TO THE INSPECTION BY THE COMMISSION AND ITS AUTHORIZED AGENTS.

SEC. 10-410. PROHIBITIONS.

A GROWER KNOWINGLY MAY NOT:

- (1) FAIL TO MAKE A REPORT TO THE COMMISSION AS PROVIDED IN §10-408;
- (2) REPORT FALSELY THE QUANTITY OF APPLES SOLD BY HIM DURING ANY PERIOD TO THE COMMISSION;
- (3) FAIL TO KEEP RECORDS AS REQUIRED BY §10-409;
