

(4) FALSIFY THE RECORDS OF THE APPLES SOLD BY HIM, OR

(5) WILFULLY FAIL TO PAY THE TAX IMPOSED BY §10-406.

SUBTITLE 5. TRADEMARKS FOR FARM PRODUCTS.

SEC. 10-501. DEFINITIONS.

(A) IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(B) "FARM PRODUCT" MEANS ANY AGRICULTURAL, HORTICULTURAL, VEGETABLE, OR FRUIT PRODUCT OF THE SOIL, WHETHER RAW, CANNED, FROZEN, DRIED, PICKLED, OR OTHERWISE PROCESSED; LIVESTOCK, MEATS, MARINE FOOD PRODUCTS, POULTRY, EGGS, DAIRY PRODUCTS; AND WOOL, HIDES, FEATHERS, NUTS, HONEY AND EVERY PRODUCT OF FARM, FOREST, ORCHARD, GARDEN, OR WATER.

SEC. 10-502. POWERS OF SECRETARY.

THE SECRETARY MAY:

(1) DEVISE AND ESTABLISH OFFICIAL TRADEMARKS OR OTHER INSIGNIA FOR FARM PRODUCTS OF THE STATE AND SECURE COPYRIGHTS FOR THEM UNDER THE LAW OF THE UNITED STATES OR THE STATE;

(2) PERMIT THE USE OF OFFICIAL TRADEMARKS OR OTHER INSIGNIA ON FARM PRODUCTS OF THE STATE OR ON THEIR CONTAINERS AND CHARGE REASONABLE AND NECESSARY FEES FOR THIS USE;
