(J) "SECONDARY STANDARDS" MEANS THE PHYSICAL STANDARDS TRACEABLE TO THE PRIMARY STANDARD THROUGH ACCEPTABLE LABORATORY COMPARISONS AND USED IN ENFORCING WEIGHTS AND MEASURES LAWS AND RULES AND REGULATIONS.

(K) "SELL" MEANS FARTER AND EXCHANGE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection presently appears as Art. 97, §35(3) of the Code. The only changes made are in style.

(L) "WEIGHT" MEANS NET WEIGHT AS USED IN THIS SUBTITLE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection presently appears as Art. 97, §22 of the Code. The last sentence is proposed for deletion because it appears as new language in §11-309. The only other changes made are in style.

(M) "WEIGHT AND MEASURE" MEANS ANY INSTRUMENT OR DEVICE USED FOR WEIGHING OR MEASURING, AND ANY APPLIANCE OR ACCESSORY ASSOCIATED WITH ANY INSTRUMENT OR DEVICE USED FOR WEIGHING OR MEASURING.

REVISOR'S NOTE:

This subsection is new language derived from Art. 97, §35(2) of the Code. The present use of the phrase weight or measure is omitted because the definition of this term clearly indicates that the conjunctive "and" is intended even where the present statute uses the disjunctive "or".
