SEC. 11-503. WEIGHMASTER LICENSE.

(A) LICENSE.

NO PERSON MAY ISSUE A DELIVERY TICKET FOR SOLID FUEL UNLESS THE SOLID FUEL HAS BEEN WEIGHED BY A WEIGHMASTER LICENSED BY THE SECRETARY.

(B) APPLICATION.

APPLICATION FOR A LICENSE SHALL BE MADE UPON THE FORM THE SECRETARY PRESCRIBES. THE APPLICATION SHALL STATE THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF THE APPLICANT'S EMPLOYER AND SHALL BE VERIFIED BY THE OATH OF THE APPLICANT. IN ADDITION, THE APPLICANT SHALL FURNISH SATISFACTORY EVIDENCE OF GOOD MORAL CHARACTER, AND ABILITY TO WEIGH ACCURATELY AND MAKE CORRECT WEIGHT TICKETS.

(C) FEE.

THE SECRETARY MAY ISSUE A LICENSE UPON THE PAYMENT OF ANNUAL LICENSE FEE ESTABLISHED BY RULE OR REGULATION.

(D) RENEWAL; NOTIFICATION OR CHANGE OF EMPLOYER'S NAME OR ADDRESS.

THE LICENSE MAY BE RENEWED ANNUALLY UPON PAYMENT OF THE FEE. EVERY LICENSED WEIGHMASTER SHALL NOTIFY THE SECRETARY IN WRITING OF ANY CHANGE IN NAME OR ADDRESS OF HIS EMPLOYER.

(E) DISPLAY.

THE LICENSE SHALL BE MAINTAINED IN THE PLACE WHERE THE WEIGHMASTER IS ENGAGED IN WEIGHING AND SHALL BE OPEN TO INSPECTION.

(F) SUSPENSION OR REVOCATION.

UPON DUE NOTICE, THE SECRETARY MAY SUSPEND OR REVOKE A LICENSE AFTER HEARING, FOR DISHONESTY, INCOMPETENCY, INACCURACY, OR ANY VIOLATION OF ANY PROVISION OF THIS SUBTITLE.
