SEC. 9-306. SHORT TITLE.

SEC. 9-307. SEVERABILITY.

IF ANY PROVISION OF THIS SUBTITLE OR THE APPLICATION THEREOF TO ANY PERSON OR CIRCUMSTANCE IS HELD INVALID, SUCH INVALIDITY SHALL NOT AFFECT OTHER PROVISIONS OR APPLICATIONS OF THE SUBTITLE WHICH CAN BE GIVEN EFFECT WITHOUT THE INVALID PROVISION OR APPLICATION AND TO THIS END THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE ARE DECLARED TO BE SEVERABLE.

SUBTITLE 4. FOREIGN DEPOSITIONS.

SEC. 9-401. AUTHORITY TO ACT.

WHENEVER ANY MANDATE, WRIT, OR COMMISSION IS ISSUED OUT OF ANY COURT OF RECORD IN ANY OTHER STATE, TERRITORY, DISTRICT, OR FOREIGN JURISDICTION, OR WHENEVER UPON NOTICE OR AGREEMENT IT IS REQUIRED TO TAKE THE TESTIMONY OF A WITNESS OR WITNESSES IN THIS STATE, WITNESSES MAY BE COMPELLED TO APPEAR AND
