

CR TO WHICH HE PLEADED GUILTY, OR NOLO CONTENDERE, OR IF NEITHER CONVICTION NOR PLEA OF GUILTY OR NOLO CONTENDERE WAS HAD, TO TRY THE PERSON ACCUSED ON THE CHARGE.

(D) A CHARGE OF VIOLATION OF THE TERMS OF PROBATION OR SUSPENSION OF SENTENCE SHALL BE HEARD BY THE JUDGE WHO ORIGINALLY HEARD THE MATTER AND IMPOSED THE TERMS, AND IF PROBATION IS REVOKED OR SUSPENSION STRICKEN, THE DEFENDANT SHALL BE SENTENCED BY THAT JUDGE, UNLESS HE HAS BEEN REMOVED FROM OFFICE, HAS DIED OR RESIGNED, OR IS OTHERWISE INCAPACITATED, IN ANY OF WHICH EVENT ANY OTHER JUDGE OF THE DISTRICT COURT HAS FULL POWER TO ACT IN THE MATTER.

(c) The Commissioner shall have custody of and maintain all records relating to the issuance of patents, including all books, dockets, and papers relating thereto which were formerly in the custody of the Commissioner of the Land Office. He shall upon request and payment of any fees required by law, certify copies of such records; and such certification shall have the same effect that certification by the Commissioner of the Land Office had on January 1, 1967.
