FOR the purpose of requiring the periodic disclosure of certain assets, liabilities, income, gifts, and other interests by certain State officials and certain candidates for State office, creating the Financial Disclosure Advisory Board and providing for its composition, powers, and responsibilities, providing for the enforcement of disclosure requirements, [[requesting]] directing the Court
