ADVANCE OF A HEARING, THE PROPOSED FIVE-YEAR PLAN SHALL BE SUBMITTED TO EACH COUNTY AND PERSON AGAINST WHOM CHARGES WILL BE LEVIED IF THE PLAN IS ADOPTED AND SECRETARIES OF NATURAL RESOURCES, STATE PLANNING, AND HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE FOR REVIEW AND COMMENT. A FIVE-YEAR PLAN CAN BE ADOPTED BY SERVICE ONLY AFTER IT IS SUBMITTED TO AND APPROVED BY RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF EACH COUNTY AFFECTED BY THE PLAN, OR IF THE PLAN IS NOT APPROVED BY EACH OF THE APPROPRIATE GOVERNING BODIES WITHIN 120 DAYS FOLLOWING SUBMISSION OF THE PLAN FOR APPROVAL GOVERNING BODIES, [[OR]] AFTER THE APPROVED BY JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE GENERAL IF A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY. ASS EMBLY APPROVING A FIVE-YEAR PLAN CONTAINS ANY AMENDMENTS MODIFICATIONS TO THE PLAN, THOSE AMENDMENTS AND MODIFICATIONS REPEAL THE PLAN TO THE EXTENT OF ANY INCONSISTENCY. THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE DO NOT AUTHORIZE THE SERVICE TO TAKE ANY ACTION WHICH WOULD BE INCONSISTENT WITH THE AMENDMENTS OR MODIFICATIONS WITHOUT THE APPROVAL OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF EACH COUNTY INCLUDED WITHIN THE PLAN.

ESTABLISHMENT OF SERVICE DISTRICTS: (F) ACQUISITION OF FACILITIES AND MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION OF PROJECTS .-- UPON ADOPTION OF A FIVE-YEAR PLAN BY THE SERVICE, SERVICE DISTRICTS SHALL BE ESTABLISHED IN THE MANNER AND FOLLOWING THE SCHEDULE SET FORTH IN THE PLAN. IMMEDIATELY THEREAFTER, THE SERVICE SHALL PROCEED WITH THE ACQUISITION, EXTENSION, AND CONSTRUCTION OF FACILITIES SET FORTH IN THE PLAN AND ASSUME JURISDICTION OVER AND PROVIDE FOR THE MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION OF WATER SUPPLY, WASTE WATER PURIFICATION AND SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL PROJECTS INCLUDED IN THE PLAN, FOR THOSE PROJECTS WITHIN THE SERVICE REGION AND DISTRICTS PLACED UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE SERVICE BY THE PLAN.
