(C) THE SERVICE AND ~~[[THE HARFORD COUNTY METROPOLITAN COMMISSION]]~~ HARFORD COUNTY MAY MAKE ANY AGREEMENT NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT THE OBJECTIVE OF PROVIDING ADEQUATE WATER SUPPLY AND WASTE WATER TREATMENT SYSTEMS IN HARFORD COUNTY. ANY AGREEMENT MAY INCLUDE STATE AND FEDERAL GRANTS AND COOPERATIVE ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE COOPERATIVE USE OF THE WATER SUPPLY, DRAINAGE, AND SANITARY FACILITIES OF BOTH THE SERVICE AND ~~[[THE HARFORD COUNTY METROPOLITAN COMMISSION.]]~~ HARFORD COUNTY. THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF HARFORD COUNTY SHALL APPROVE ANY AGREEMENT MADE UNDER THIS SECTION.

3-108. MANDATORY AGREEMENT TO PROVIDE REQUESTED SERVICES.

(A) REQUEST FOR PROJECT.—ANY MUNICIPALITY OR PERSON MAY REQUEST THE SERVICE TO PROVIDE THE WATER SUPPLY, WASTE WATER PURIFICATION OR SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL PROJECTS AUTHORIZED BY THIS SUBTITLE. THE REQUEST SHALL SET FORTH THE TYPE OF PROPOSED PROJECT TO BE FURNISHED AND THE PROPOSED BOUNDARIES OF THE AREA WITHIN WHICH A PROJECT IS REQUESTED.
