Fisheries Administration, its general duties, responsibility, staff, etc. To this extent, it is treated differently than the Water Resources Administration. See section 8-201 of this Article.

4-202. RESPONSIBILITY OF SECRETARY - IN GENERAL.

THE SECRETARY IS RESPONSIBLE FOR CONSERVATION MANAGEMENT OF THE FISH, FISHERIES, FISH RESOURCES AND AQUATIC LIFE [[OF]] WITHIN THE STATE.

4-203. TRANSFER OF JURISDICTION OF DEPARTMENT OF GAME AND INLAND FISH AND FISH AND WILDLIFE ADMINISTRATION TO DEPARTMENT.

EVERY RIGHT, POWER, DUTY, OBLIGATION, AND PUNCTION PREVIOUSLY CONFERRED UPON OR EXERCISED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF GAME AND INLAND FISH OR THE FISH AND WILDLIFE ADMINISTRATION IS TRANSFERRED TO AND MAY BE EXERCISED BY THE DEPARTMENT. EVERY REFERENCE TO THE DEPARTMENT OF GAME AND INLAND FISH OR THE FISH AND WILDLIFE ADMINISTRATION WHICH APPEARS IN THE CODE, IN ANY OTHER STATE LAW, OR IN ANY ORDINANCE, RESOLUTION, RULE, REGULATION, LEGAL ACTION, DIRECTIVE, OR DOCUMENT, MEANS THE DEPARTMENT.

4-204. DEPARTMENT ADVISORY COMMISSIONS.

- (A) COMMERCIAL FISHERIES ADVISORY COMMISSION CREATED AND CONTINUED.—— THE COMMERCIAL FISHERIES ADVISORY COMMISSION IS CREATED AND CONTINUED WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT.
- (B) SPORT FISHERIES ADVISORY COMMISSION CREATED AND CONTINUED.— THE SPORT PISHERIES ADVISORY COMMISSION IS CREATED AND CONTINUED WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT.
