WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT'S JURISDICTION SHALL KEEP ACCURATE ECOKS, STATEMENTS, AND ACCOUNTS SHOWING EVERY DETAIL OF THE BUSINESS. EVERY BOOK, STATEMENT, AND ACCOUNT SHALL BE OPEN FOR THE DEPARTMENT TO INSPECT AT REASONABLE HOURS. EVERY PERSON ENGAGED IN THE BUSINESS OF PACKING OR DEALING IN ANY FISH RESOURCE WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT'S JURISDICTION, AND EVERY PERSON THE DEPARTMENT LICENSES TO CATCH THE RESOURCE SHALL MAKE ANY REPORT THE DEPARTMENT REQUIRES ON FORMS THE DEPARTMENT PRESCRIEES.

EMPLOYEE OF EXECUTIVE BRANCH MAY NOT REVEAL INFORMATION IN REPORTS; EXCEPTION. - AN OFFICER OR EMPLOYEE OF ANY DEPARTMENT OR [[AGENCY]] UNIT OF THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH OF STATE GOVERNMENT MAY NOT DIVULGE USF IN ANY MANNER INFORMATION CONTAINED IN ANY REPORT SUBMITTED PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF REVEAL INCOME OF SECTION THAT WOULD THE PERSON[[,]] SUBMITTING THE REPORT. THIS SECTION PROHIBIT THE PUBLICATION OF STATISTICS CLASSIFIED TO PREVENT THE IDENTIFICATION OF PARTICULAR AND ITEMS OF THEM, OR TO PROHIBIT INSPECTION OF REPORTS AND RECORDS BY ANY OFFICIAL OR EMPLOYEE OF THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH HAVING A PROPER INTEREST IN THEM.
