CARROLL, WASHINGTON, AND FREDERICK COUNTIES.

- (3) BUSH-BOBS OR BANKPOLES MAY NOT BE USED ON ANY STREAMS STCCKED WITH TROUT.
- (4) A BUSH-BOB OR BANKPOLE WHICH HAS BEEN BAITED WITH SCALE BAIT OR LIVE BAIT MAY NOT BE USED TO CATCH SUCKERS, CATFISH, CARP, EELS, GUDGEONS AND EVERY SPECIES OF SUNFISH, INCLUDING BLUEGILLS AND ROCK EASS, COMMONLY KNOWN AS REDEYE.
- (5) A BUSH-BOB OR BANKPOLE MAY NOT BE USED EXCEPT BETWEEN SUNSET AND SUNPISE.
- (E) ICE-FISHING.—THE DEPARTMENT MAY REGULATE, SUPERVISE, AND CONTROL ICE-FISHING.
- (F) WHITE SHAD, HICKORY SHAD, AND HERRING.—WHITE SHAD, HICKORY SHAD, AND HERRING MAY BE CAUGHT OR TAKEN ONLY BY ANGLING, UNLESS OTHERWISE PROVIDED.
- (G) BLACK BASS.—A PERSON MAY CATCH LARGE OR SMALL MOUTH BLACK BASS FROM NONTIDAL WATERS OF THE STATE ONLY BY ANGLING. AN ARTIFICIAL LURE IS LEGAL.
 - REVISOR'S NOTE: Subsections (a), (b), (c), (d), and (e) presently appear as Article 66C, section 209 of the Code. The last phrase of section 209(a) is proposed for deletion and set forth as a new subsection (e).
