

FEE. A NEW LICENSE MAY NOT BE ISSUED IF THE OUTSTANDING LICENSE IS SUSPENDED OR REVOKED AT THE TIME OF THE TRANSFER.

(B) GILL NETS. - A COMMERCIAL NET FISHING LICENSE TO SET A GILL NET MAY BE TRANSFERRED ONLY TO THE WIDOW, FATHER, BROTHER, SISTER, SON, OR DAUGHTER OF THE LICENSEE AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (A).

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section presently appears as Article 66C, section 304 of the Code. The reference to section 299 has been omitted since the version of the section it referred to was repealed by Chapter 588 Acts of 1970. The present reference to section 262 is also proposed for deletion for its provisions are within this subtitle.

4-707. REVOCATION AND SUSPENSION OF LICENSE.

IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER PENALTY PROVIDED IN THIS TITLE, THE DEPARTMENT MAY REVOKE OR SUSPEND FOR A PERIOD OF NOT LESS THAN TEN DAYS, ANY LICENSE IT ISSUES PURSUANT TO THIS SUBTITLE AFTER A HEARING IS HELD UPON NOT LESS THAN TEN DAYS PRIOR NOTICE TO THE LICENSEE. THE FOLLOWING GROUNDS ARE GROUNDS FOR REVOCATION OR SUSPENSION:

(1) MAKING ANY FALSE STATEMENT IN THE APPLICATION FOR A NET LICENSE;

(2) CONVICTION OF THE LICENSEE OR HIS AGENTS OF ANY VIOLATION OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE;

(3) VIOLATION OF ANY DEPARTMENT RULE OR REGULATION;

(4) FAILURE TO MAKE THE REPORTS PRESCRIBED BY LAW OR BY THE DEPARTMENT PURSUANT TO LAW.

4-708. PROHIBITION TO OPERATE NET WHEN LICENSE
