

- (3) CATFISH LESS THAN EIGHT INCHES;
- (4) CROAKERS OR HARDHEADS LESS THAN 10 INCHES;
- (5) PERCH, WHITE OR YELLOW, LESS THAN EIGHT INCHES, IF CAUGHT OTHER THAN BY HOOK OR LINE;
- (6) PIKE OR WALLEYED PIKE LESS THAN 14 INCHES;
- (7) SEA TROUT OR WEAFFISH LESS THAN NINE INCHES;
- (8) STRIPED BASS, LESS THAN 12 INCHES IN LENGTH OR WEIGHING MORE THAN 15 POUNDS. HOWEVER, A PERSON MAY CATCH ONE STRIPED BASS OVER 15 POUNDS PER DAY WITH HOOK AND LINE IN THE SUSQUEHANNA RIVER ABOVE HOG BACK SHOALS AND IN THE WATERS OF THE STATE AT ANY TIME OF THE YEAR EXCEPT FROM MARCH 1 TO MAY 27 INCLUSIVE, WHICH MAY NOT BE SOLD OR OFFERED FOR SALE.
- (9) STURGEON WEIGHING LESS THAN 25 POUNDS;
- (10) TAYLOR OR BLUE FISH LESS THAN EIGHT INCHES.
- MEASUREMENT FOR EACH FISH MENTIONED ABOVE SHALL BE FROM THE TIP OF THE NOSE TO THE END OF THE TAIL.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section presently appears as Article 66C, section 293 of the Code. It is revised for purposes of organization. In paragraph (1) reference is added to black bass to allow for the proposed deletion of language which duplicates section 316. The only other changes made are in style.

4-735. FISHING RESTRICTIONS CONCERNING BLACK BASS AND CHAIN PICKEREL.

(A) CREEL LIMIT. - DURING THE OPEN SEASON, A PERSON MAY NOT CATCH BY MEANS OF ROD, OR HOOK AND LINE, MORE THAN FIVE BLACK BASS OR TEN CHAIN PICKEREL IN ANY ONE DAY.

(B) CLOSED SEASON; SALE OR POSSESSION PROHIBITED DURING THAT TIME.— A PERSON MAY NOT CATCH BLACK BASS OR CHAIN PICKEREL IN THE TIDAL WATERS OF THE STATE DURING THE PERIOD FROM MARCH 15 TO APRIL 30. A PERSON MAY NOT SELL OR OFFER TO SELL, PURCHASE, OR OFFER TO
