## GENERAL REVISOR'S NOTE:

The Commission To Revise The Annotated Code, in compiling Title 4 of the Natural Resources Article, concluded that certain provisions of present law originally allocated to Title 4 are repetitious, obsolete, or more properly allocable elsewhere. Accordingly, these provisions are not embodied in Title 4. Their proposed treatment is as follows:
